

## Frequently Asked Questions

### **Who is this for?**

These sessions are designed for art students, emerging artists, and practitioners seeking critical dialogue and professional guidance. Depending on the consultation, sessions are suitable for artists developing new projects, refining existing work, writing artist statements, preparing portfolios, or applying for exhibitions, residencies, grants, and graduate programs.

### **What should I prepare?**

After booking, you will receive an email with a **google form link** which includes instructions outlining what materials to share in advance. Depending on the session, this may include images of artworks, project descriptions, artist statements, portfolios, CVs, websites, or application materials. Supporting notes, research, and references are also welcome.

### **How does it work?**

All sessions are conducted online via Google Meet. Once your booking is received, your time slot is reserved, and you will receive an invoice and a link to submit your materials before the meeting. Sessions are confirmed once payment has been received.

### **How do I pay?**

Your mentorship package is reserved at the time of booking and confirmed once payment has been received. An invoice and payment instructions will be sent after booking. Payment is required within 24 hours of receiving the invoice, unless otherwise agreed.

### **Can I cancel or reschedule a session?**

Yes. The session may be cancelled or rescheduled up to 24 hours before the scheduled appointment. Cancellations or rescheduling requests made less than 24 hours before the session may not be eligible for a refund. Once the consultation series has begun, refunds for completed sessions are not available.

### **What happens if I am late or do not attend?**

Sessions begin at the scheduled time. If you are late, the session will still end at the originally planned time. If you do not attend without prior notice, the session may be considered completed.

### **Can beginners join?**

Yes. Some sessions are particularly suited to artists with an existing body of work, while others are open to those at earlier stages of their practice. If you are unsure which consultation is most appropriate, please get in touch before booking.

### **Will my work remain confidential?**

Yes. All discussions and materials shared during consultations are treated as strictly confidential

and handled with the utmost care and respect. Your work, ideas, and personal information will never be shared publicly or with third parties without your explicit permission.

All files and materials submitted for the consultation are used solely for the purpose of our sessions and will be permanently deleted from all storage devices after the consultation process has concluded.

**Are discounted rates available?**

Limited discounted rates are available for students and artists facing financial barriers. If cost is a concern, please feel free to get in touch regarding supported pricing.
