1. Data Controller

2. Collection and Processing of Personal Data

I collect and process personal data only to the extent necessary to provide my services. The data collected may include:

- Name
- Email address
- Telephone number (if provided)

3. Purpose of Data Processing

Your personal data is processed for the following purposes:

- Processing booking requests
- Communicating regarding appointments
- Providing artist consultation services
- Reviewing submitted portfolios and artist statements
- Issuing invoices
- Fulfilling legal accounting and tax obligations

The legal basis for processing is Article 6(1)(b) GDPR (performance of a contract) and Article 6(1)(c) GDPR (legal obligations).

4. Booking and Communication Services

If booking platforms, email providers, payment providers, or video conferencing services are used, your data may be transferred to these service providers solely for the purpose of delivering the requested service.

Services used may include:

- Payment provider: Bank transfer
- Email provider: Gmail and Professional Email

5. Submitted Materials

Portfolio materials, artist statements, images, and other documents submitted by clients are used exclusively for preparing and conducting the consultation session. These materials will not be shared with third parties without explicit consent unless required by law.

6. Storage Period

Personal data will be stored only as long as necessary for the purposes stated above or as required by applicable law. Invoices and tax-related records may be retained for the statutory retention period under German law. Once the consultation is complete, the data will be deleted from all storage devices.

7. Your Rights

3. Booking Procedure

- An intake form

The appointment is confirmed only after payment has been received and all required materials have been submitted.

4. Client Materials

The Client agrees to provide all requested materials in a timely manner, including portfolio documents and a written artist statement draft when required.

The Client retains all intellectual property rights to submitted materials.

5. Fees and Payment

The applicable consultation fee is displayed on the website.

Payment must be completed before the consultation session takes place. Payment methods accepted are specified in the invoice.

6. Cancellation and Rescheduling

Clients may reschedule or cancel appointments up to 24 hours before the scheduled session without charge.

Cancellations made less than 24 hours before the appointment may not be refunded.

In the event of technical problems or circumstances beyond the Provider's control, a replacement appointment will be offered.

7. Delivery of Services

Consultations are conducted online using video conferencing software. The Client is responsible for ensuring access to a stable internet connection and suitable equipment.

8. Limitation of Liability

The Provider offers professional guidance and feedback based on experience and expertise. No guarantee is made regarding artistic, academic, or commercial outcomes resulting from the consultation.

Liability is limited to cases of intentional misconduct and gross negligence, except where mandatory legal provisions provide otherwise.

The Client retains all rights, title, and interest in their artworks, portfolio materials, artist statements, written texts, images, and all other materials submitted for consultation.
